Senate advances homosexual agenda

DENVER, CO: In a payoff to liberal donors who funded 527 political committees supporting Democrat candidates, the Colorado Senate passed a bill this morning to permit homosexual adoption.

"This bill is about the homosexual agenda; it's not about what's best for our children," stated Senator Scott Renfroe (R-Eaton), a member of the Republican Study Committee of Colorado (RSCC), during the floor debate. "This bill undermines the family."

HB07-1330, sponsored by Senator Jennifer Veiga (D - Denver) and Representative Alice Madden (D - Boulder), tries to legislate significant elements of Referenda I which was overwhelmingly defeated by the voters of Colorado last fall.

"This bill is not only an attack upon the family; it is an attack upon the will of the people of Colorado. It is shameful that we are ignoring the will of the voters who overwhelmingly opposed homosexual adoption last November," declared Senator Dave Schultheis (R-Colorado Springs), a founding member of the RSCC. "Liberals and the homosexual lobby are legislating what they failed to achieve at the ballot box, and that is wrong. Their arrogance is sickening."

HB07-1330 adds to other pro-homosexual legislation this year to redefine the family, to force businesses to hire and retain transsexuals and cross dressers, and to grant sexual orientation the same protected status as gender and race.

"This is a blatant example that absolute power corrupts absolutely," stated Senator Ted Harvey (R-Highlands Ranch), an RSCC founding member. "After the overwhelming defeat of Ref I only a few short months ago, the power drunk Democrat majority is now working hand in hand with their radical homosexual financiers to ignore the electoral will of the people of Colorado."

"Democrats are playing pay-back politics, plain and simple, with no regard or respect for the people of Colorado," added Representative Kent Lambert (R - Colorado Springs), RSCC Chairman.
